


DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DRINKING WATER: Use as an aid in the reduction of bacteria in processed drinking water for livestock and poultry. Use 1/3 to 1-1/2 fluid oz. per gallon of water. Use 1/3 fluid oz. under normal conditions. Use 1-1/2 fluid oz. when water contains high bacterial contamination.

POULTRY LITTER: Apply 6 fluid oz. in one gallon of water to each 1,000 square feet of litter using a low-pressure sprayer.

FEED: Use 28.75 fluid oz. (2 pounds) per ton. When used in feed, do not dilute.

SILAGE STORAGE: Remove all old silage and dirt from all interior surfaces of the storage areas. Mix 6 fluid oz. in one gallon of water. Apply this solution to 1000 square feet of surface storage areas using a low-pressure sprayer.

GRAIN STORAGE: Remove all old grain and dirt from all interior surfaces of the storage areas. Mix 6 fluid oz. in one gallon of water. Apply this solution to 1000 square feet of surface storage areas using a low-pressure sprayer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water or food by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a warm, dry place above 40° F to prevent freezing.

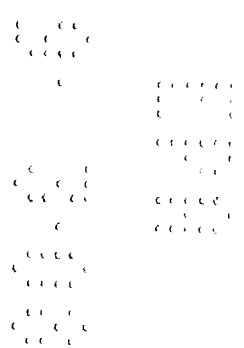
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Offer for reconditioning, if appropriate. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
