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TEST FOR BLEACHABILITY

To test a colored fabric, wash an area with 1/4 cup of bleach in a fabric of the same composition. For bleachability, apply a mixture of 1 tablespoon of bleach to a gallon of hot water to an inconspicuous corner and let stand for 3-5 minutes. If fading or color fades or yellows, it is not bleachable.

CAUTION — Keep out of reach of children. If splashed in eyes, flush with water. If splashed on skin, rinse off with water. If swallowed, do not milk — Call physician. Do not mix with toilet bowl cleaners or acids as toxic fumes may develop.

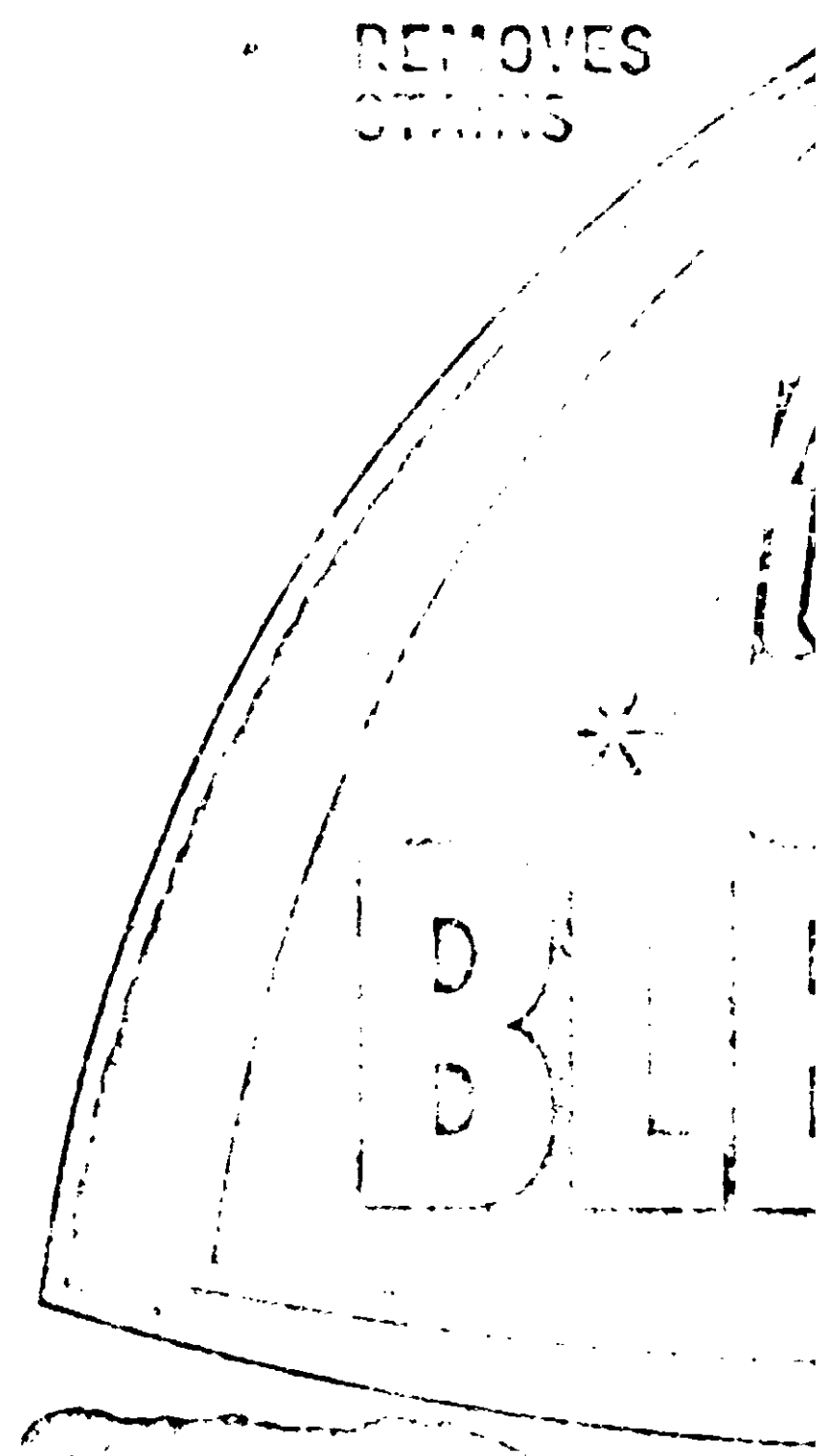

LAUNDRING. To bleach and sanitize white and colorfast cotton, linen, nylon, dacron, orlon and rayon in washing machine.	1 cup KANDU bleach per load for conventional washing machine, 1/4 cup for front load automatic.	Add to pre-rinse, wash water or first rinse if clothes are in machine. Dilute bleach in 1 quart water before adding.
