PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS to Humans and Domestic Animals

**DANGER
CORROSIVE**

Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the pesticide registered under EPA Reg. No. 8601-2

DIRECTION FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Product is recommended for dairies, food processing plants and restaurants on all types of hard surfaces (floor, shelves, walls, ceiling) and equipment where food is processed or prepared. Removal of gross food particles and soil is necessary by prescrape, presoak or preflush. Wash all surfaces or equipment with detergent and rinse with potable water before sanitizer is used.

4 oz - 4 Full 1 oz strokes of pump in sink compartment of 16 gallons of water (200 ppm Active Quaternary). Solution to be used for immersion or spray bottle.

Use full strength in white handled Q-Qm preset at 200 ppm Active Quaternary.

Wet all surfaces for a contact time of one minute. Let air dry.

Fresh sanitizer solution should be prepared daily or more often using the test tape to maintain 200 ppm Active Quaternary.
