A medicated livestock mineral supplement that prevents the breeding of Face and Horn Flies in the manure of treated cattle. Appreciably suppresses egg production and larva development of the stomach worm (Haemonchus), nodular worm (Oesophagostomum), hook worm (Bunostomum), and a lesser extent medium stomach worms (Ostertagia) and small hairworms (Trichostrongylus).

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Fly-Away Special Cattle Mineral is an effective economical method to prevent the breeding of face flies and horn flies and aid in the prevention of some internal parasites in cattle. Fly-Away should be used on a continuous low level daily administration of 1/4 gram phenothiazine per 100 pounds of body weight.

TO FEED -- TOP DRESSING METHOD

This 4-Phenothiazine Fly-Away Special Cattle Mineral Premix contains 18 grams of phenothiazine per pound. Therefore, one (1) pound premix should be fed daily to every nine (9) head of cattle; ten (10) pounds premix daily to ninety (90) head, etc.

TO FEED -- FREE CHOICE METHOD

To feed "free choice" we recommend hand mixing two (2) parts Fly-Away Mineral premix to one (1) part salt. This mixture will result in the following calculated analysis:

Calcium (Ca),	12.00%
Phosphorus (P),	6.00%
Iodine (I),	0.03%
Salt (NaCl),	33.00%
Phenothiazine	2.66%
Vitamin A ... USP Units per lb.	66,666

This resulting 2.66% Phenothiazine Free-Choice Mix would contain twelve (12) grams phenothiazine per pound. One pound Free-Choice Mix should be consumed daily by six (6) animals; ten (10) pounds mix daily by sixty (60) animals; etc. In the event consumption is low, add a small amount of palatable feed, such as ground corn, soybean meal, or dried molasses.

When using this "Free-Choice" method do not feed any other mineral or salt free-choice. Locate Fly-Away Free Choice mix in bunks and feeders near the animals watering and loafing areas. Check consumption and clean feeders regularly.

For maximum protection against the face and horn fly, cattle should be on a phenothiazine program several weeks prior to the appearance of adult horn flies in the spring, and fed continuously until the flies disappears in the fall. Fly-Away phenothiazine program prevents the breeding of horn flies, but have no effect on existing adult fly populations. Since horn flies overwinter in the pupal state, all cattle should be sprayed when the flies first appear. This kills flies emerging from last year's pupal, and protect the cattle for about two (2) weeks until Fly-Away phenothiazine feed can take effect.
