DIRECTIONS

PLACE MOUSE-MAIZE IN TAMPERPROOF CONTAINERS OR IN LOCATIONS NOT ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN, PETS, OR DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

FOR MEDIUM INFESTATIONS IN WAREHOUSES, AND BARNs, PLACE MOUSE-MAIZE IN TEASPOONFULS QUANTITIES EVERY TEN FEET ALONG WALLS AND ALLEYS. SMALL CONTAINERS OR BOXES WITH HOLES SHOULD BE USED. TO PREVENT REINFESTATION, REMOVE AND BURN CONTAMINATED BAIT AND REPLENISH EVERY MONTH. AT LEAST TEN POUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED.

FOR HEAVY INFESTATIONS IN WAREHOUSES, BARNs AND IN POULTRY HOUSES, PLACE A QUARTER POUND OF MOUSE-MAIZE IN BAIT BOXES ALONG WALLS AND IN ALLEYS. EXAMINE BAIT EVERY WEEK AND REPLACE WITH FRESH BAIT WHEN BAIT BECOMES CONTAMINATED BY MICE. IN MANY INSTANCES AT LEAST 50 POUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THE PRELIMINARY PLACEMENT.

ANTIDOTE:

If less than ten minutes has passed since the poison was taken, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Have victim lie down in a quiet, darkened room and keep him warm. Call a Physician immediately!

DANGER . . CONVULSIVE POISON!

Do not contaminate food and feedstuffs. Keep away from children and domestic animals. When empty, all containers and all grain fragments must be burned or buried deeply.

Where placement of strychnine-treated grain presents a hazard to wildlife or livestock, all placements must be made under existing or introduced cover of brush or weeds.

DIRECTIONS

PLACE MOUSE-MAIZE IN TAMPERPROOF CONTAINERS OR IN LOCATIONS NOT ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN, PETS, OR DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

FOR LIGHT INFESTATIONS WHERE THERE ARE ONLY A FEW MICE, PLACE A TEASPOONFUL OF MOUSE-MAIZE IN TWO OR THREE DIFFERENT LOCATIONS IN THE INFECTED AREA. MOUSE-MAIZE SHOULD BE PLACED IN SMALL CONTAINERS TO PREVENT MICE FROM SCATTERING THE BAIT. UNEATEN BAIT AND CONTAINERS SHOULD BE DESTROYED BY BURNING WHEN NO FURTHER SIGN OF MICE IS NOTED. ONE QUARTER POUND SHOULD BE SUFFICIENT.
