HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Use as a space spray in food processing plants only when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed during treatment. All food surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to do so by a physician.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not contaminate water supplies by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For most effective results, use in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist for flying insects, a coarse spray for crawling insects.

Dilute to 0.5% SBP-1382 by adding one part by weight of the 2.5% concentrate to four parts of petroleum distillate.

Dilute to 0.25% SBP-1382 by adding one part by weight of the 2.5% concentrate to nine parts of petroleum distillate.

Dilute to 0.10% SBP-1382 (which would be used for flying insects only) by adding one part by weight of the 2.5% concentrate to 24 parts of petroleum distillate.

FLYING INSECT CONTROL

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECT CONTROL

ROACHES, EARWIGS, CRACK MITE, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, AND CENTIPEDES: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in an area inaccessible to children and pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state or local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
