

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Wear mask or respirator of a type recommended by the U.S. Bureau of Mines to give adequate protection against this material. Wash hands, arms and face with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Keep container closed.

In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Use in food processing plants only when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed during treatment. All food surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to do so by a physician.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public water unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in a NPDES permit. For most effective results, use in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist for flying insects and a coarse spray for crawling insects.

CONTACT SPRAY

For control of roaches, wasps, ants, fleas and other listed crawling insects. Mix 1 1/4 fluid ounces of SYN-PY-3 EC in a gallon of water to make a 0.25% emulsion. Mix well before using. Directions for each insect treatment are given below.

ROACHES: Spray thoroughly into hiding and moist areas around pipes, under re. Spray directly on insects when possible.

WASPS: Application should be made in rest. Spray liberally into hiding and bre insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS - ROACHES, EARL SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES: Spray thoro cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings refrigerators, baseboards and storage i where possible.

FLEAS: Liberal application should be n cracks, crevices, sleeping quarters of wherever these insects may be suspe repeated area application, to insure con are necessary for control.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLIES, GNATS AND MOSQUITOES: F mosquitoes, remove or cover exposed f including utensils. Remove animals. Shut and air conditioning equipment.

Mix 4-1/2 fluid ounces of the SYN-PY-3 0.1% emulsion. Mix well before using. Ap 2 fluid ounces per 64,000 cubic feet. Di room and along ceiling. Avoid inhaling t! at least one- half hour after spraying. Ventilate room before re-entry. Sweep Repeat as necessary.
