

CAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION

DOR-CHEX Dormant Oil is formulated specially to break on contact with the tree, the water running off to leave the desired oil in place, and must be used in equipment that provides constant agitation. Weather conditions and methods of application may affect the effectiveness of this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in an area inaccessible to children and pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
