e. Revise the Precautionary Statement as follows:

Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of feed or food stuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before apraying or surface applications. Do not use on humans. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.



To control carpet beetles. Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to floor and carpening and rugs. wake exemited application to inder and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and infested areas of shelving. Repeat treatment as needed.

To control bedbugs. Spray mattresses lightly, particularly around that rid seems. Take beds spart and spray at all joints. Treat baseconards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as needed.

To control flees and ticks (adults and larvae) It eroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearly crackle and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and entire areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in snimel quarters following treatment, stepess

To control clothes withs. Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight if possible. Apply apray liberally to empty chests, closets, bignand and other atorages directing into cracks, joint, and crevices "Afgrairing, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping no the at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining."

To kill lice and louse eggs. Spray in an inconspicous area to text for possible staining or discoloration, inspect again after deving, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Spray from a distance of 8 to 16 inches. Treat only those garments and parts of bedding, including mettresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use.


SPACE SPRAYING

Close doors and studows and shut off ventilating systems. Apply with a good machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist or fog.

For rapid control of house flies, fruit flies, gnets, inosquitoes, slipper flies, masps, hornets, bees, black flies, Angounes grain muths, Mediterraneen flour meths, Indian meel moths and tebecco moths. Direct spray at an upward angle, distributing it uniformly throughout the entire area at a rate of I ownce per 1808 cubic tool of space. Keep aron closed for I hours, Ventilate before reoccupying.

FOGGING

To kill expessed or accessible stages of the above named crawling insects use a rate of 1 gallon to 20,000 to 40,000 cubic feet of space. Contact insects directly when possible Keep area closed for human variable. Ventilete before rece

INSECTS ON DOGS

To control floss, ticks and lice: Start apraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and underbody. While apraying, fluff the heir so that the spray will not panetrate to the skin. Make sure apray were thoroughly. Do not apray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitaties. Repost as necessary.

NOTE. Not recommended for use on puppies less than four weeks

INSECTS ON LIVESTOCK

To protect cattle (beef and delivy), goats, sheep, hogs and horses from horn files, face files, house files, accaudites and gnats apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair for faces files, spray face and head, but do not apply into eyes.

To control stable flies, liorse flies and door flies. Apply at a rate of 2 nunces per adult unimal, sufficient to well the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment disly or at intervals necessary to give continued brotection.

To control blood sucking fice. Apply to the infested areas of the annul, using a stiff brush to get the apray to the bare of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control positry lice. Sprsy roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by sprsying over the hirds with a fine mat.

To control bedbugs and mites in positry houses. Spray crevices of roust poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and roise hide.

OUTDOOR APPLICATIONS

For control of garden insects for use on roses, dahlies, eater and other commentals to kill Japanese beatles hit by spray as well as whitefires, aphids, exposed thrips, spiders, red miles and leafamores.

May be used on plants as a multi-purpose apray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to present apreading in large garden areas.

ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL

Apply as a fine stiet to thoroughly treat the entire area. For best results, treat when the wind velocity does not acceed 5 miles perhour. Treat chrubbery or vegetation where mesquitoes any rust.

Apply at a rate of 2.5 pints per sore (0.9 ounce per 1000 square feet). Using truck-mounted conventional misting equipment trevaling at 5 mph to treat a 300 foot swath, calibrate equipment to deliver 8 55 galupa per minute, Upder no conditions should open water be treated with this product.
