It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO SANITIZE GLASSES, DISHES, MUGS, KNIVES, TRAYS, FOOD UTENSILS AND EQUIPMENT use the following procedure:

1. Scrape and then prewash with SANISOL solution (1 oz. or 2 level tbs. per quart of water) or other compatible detergent.
2. Rinse in potable water.
3. Sanitize in DUAL CHLOR solution (2 level tbs. or 1 oz. per gallon of potable water). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes of contact time specified by governing sanitary code. In order to properly sanitize you must maintain chlorine level at 200 ppm.
4. Sanitized utensils to be placed on a rack or drainboard to air dry.
5. Fresh DUAL CHLOR solution should be made up each morning or just before use and as frequently during the day as is necessary.

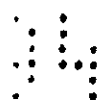
