
- 1) Delete the statement "May Burn The Skin."

Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area, in well-closed original containers, away from energy sources, acids, alkaloidal and heavy metal salts. When handling or dealing with spills, use impact-resistant goggles with side-shields or face shield; body-covering clothes, including impervious rubber or plastic gloves and boots; use a dust respirator if dusting occurs.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
