"Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

3. Revise the ingestion and "If On Skin" instruction in the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

If Swallowed: Call physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

Submit one copy of the final printed label before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.
