


4. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.


5. Refer to the enclosed copy of the Product Chemistry review for your record.

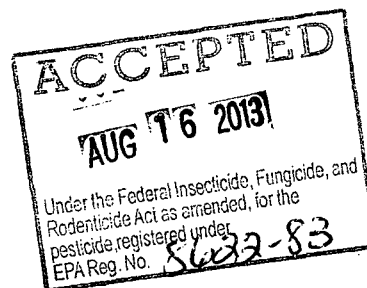

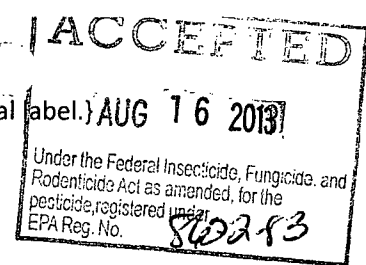

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## **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

### **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

#### **DANGER**

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Fatal if absorbed through the skin. May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled. Causes skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wear goggles and chemical resistant rubber gloves. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, and chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Avoid contact with metal equipment such as scoops, mills and sieves. Reacts with oxidizing agents.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Product should be stored in an area that is not subject to extreme temperatures. Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed.
