

### USE DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas—surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1½ ounces of Pine Oil Disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

### USE DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants and rest rooms mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1½ ounces of Pine Oil Disinfectant per gallon of water.

Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 2 ounces of Pine Oil Disinfectant per gallon of water and then disinfected. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality.

### SANITIZATION

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 1½ ounces of Pine Oil Disinfectant per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use Pine Oil Disinfectant at a rate of 2 ounces per gallon to insure thorough cleaning.

### DEODORIZATION

### DANGER

#### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
