### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is intended to be fed intermittently into the system. Chemical may be poured into the sump of the cooling tower or evaporative condenser. Approximately one gallon should be used per 10,000 gallons of water in the system. Chemical additions should be made weekly during the season when algae is likely to develop. When treating systems for the first time, add chemical in small increments to determine the extent of foaming. Your Mitco field service engineer can furnish detailed instructions.
