DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mitco CC-12L Algicide is used to control algae in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, and deposits. An initial slug addition of 6.13 to 15.32 fluid ounces of Mitco CC-12L Algicide per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 1.53 to 15.32 million of Mitco CC-12L Algicide based on the total water volume is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.53 to 15.32 fluid ounces of Mitco CC-12L Algicide per 1000 gallons of water (12 to 120 parts per million) should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or more frequently if the addition depends upon the relative amount of biological problem. Slug additions should be made to the sump of the airwash system.

Mitco CC-12L Algicide is used to control bacteria in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling systems that maintain effective mist eliminating capacity. Systems should be cleaned to remove bacterial slime and deposits. A slug dose of 24.7 to 41.2 fluid ounces of Mitco CC-12L Algicide per 1000 gallons of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected. Subsequent slug additions of 16.9 to 41.2 fluid ounces of Mitco CC-12L Algicide per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each 1 to 5 days, or more frequently if the addition depends upon the relative amount of biological problem. Slug additions may be made to the sump of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
