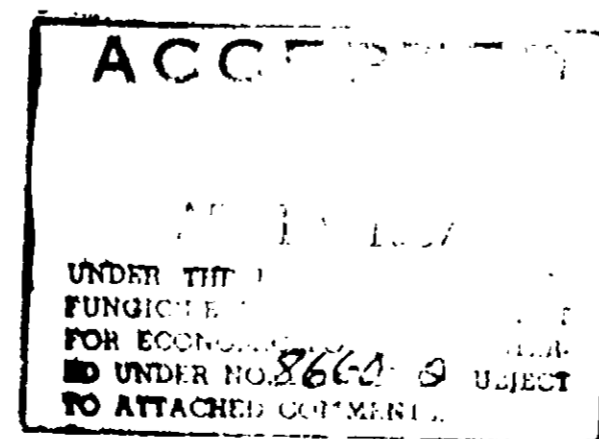

TO CONTROL

STA-GREEN Post-Emergence when it is applied according to directions will control crabgrass, dallisgrass, foxtail, young goosegrass, barnyard grass, common chickweed, house-sick chickweed, Dandelion, Plantain, Pigweed, Carolina cranesbill, Lamb's quarters, vetch, clover, and Lawn Pennywort. It will not control nutgrass, common roundel, or Veronica species.

WHEN TO USE

Use STA-GREEN Post-Emergence anytime crabgrass and other susceptible weeds are growing in the lawn--spring, summer, or early fall. It is most effective if applied when the crabgrass and weeds are young and growing vigorously. Newly planted lawns should be established and should be mowed at least twice before treatment. The material acts better during cool, dry weather and may require longer to kill.

WHERE TO USE

STA-GREEN Post-Emergence is designed for use on lawns of hybrid and common bermudagrass and on the zoysiagrasses. It should not be used on St. Augustine, or seashore or carpetgrass lawns, and it should not be used in shrub borders, flower beds, vegetable gardens, or where other desirable plants are growing. When applying to lawn, choose a relatively calm time to avoid drift of the granules to nearby shrub or flower borders.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when the lawn foliage is moist from dew, rain, or sprinkling. It is well to water and mow the lawn a few days before applying STA-GREEN Post-Emergence; and then wait at least two days after application before mowing again. If rain occurs in less than 24 hours after application, re-apply to insure effective control. Two or three applications 5 to 7 days apart will usually give satisfactory results. Three or more repeat applications may be required to kill mature crabgrass and weeds.

Apply STA-GREEN Post-Emergence granules uniformly over the entire crabgrass and weed infested lawn area using a mechanical spreader. The proper amount of granules for various turf areas is shown in the following table.

Area to be treated (sq. ft.)	STA-GREEN Post-Emergence Granules (lbs.)
1,000	4
2,000	8
2,500	10 (1 bag)
5,000	20 (2 bags)
10,000	40 (4 bags)

The delivery rate of spreaders may vary depending upon the condition of the equipment. Calibration instructions supplied with the spreader should be followed to insure that it will deliver the amount of material for which it is set.

After the crabgrass and weeds have died, fertilize the lawn to encourage rapid and healthy growth of the lawn grass and to encourage spread into the bare areas.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid getting on the skin or in the eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Keep children and pets off the treated area for several days after treatment.

Harmful if swallowed.

Keep children and animals off treated area until chemicals are washed into soil.

Avoid breathing dust or spray mist.

DO NOT re-use bag for any other purpose.

Use only at the recommended rate. Excessive rates may damage the desirable turfgrass.

Use when the wind is still to avoid drift into areas outside the lawn.

DO NOT use on St. Augustine, Centipede, or Carpetgrass lawns.

DO NOT use in shrub or flower beds.

DO NOT store in contact with fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides.
