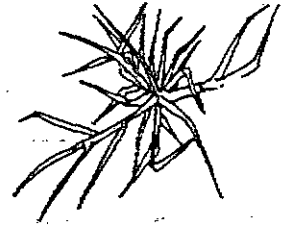

- If complete control is not obtained, a second application may be necessary 2 months after the first.
- Apply on Centipede grasses after "greening" has occurred.

*Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.*  
*Not for use on or under trees, shrubs, bedding plants, flowers or garden plants. Do not apply under the branches (rootzone area) of shrubs, trees, flowers etc.*
