#### TO CONTROL GROWING BROADLEAF WEEDS


Apply any time weeds are actively growing. If complete control is not obtained a second treatment may be required 2 months after the first. Apply in the fall to control Henbit, Chickweed and other winter Aceds.

# TO PREVENT ANNUAL WEEDS

Apply in January, February or early March to prevent ger.rkr.a.ion of annual weeds such as crabgrass, Bull Paspallum, Sedges (from send) and Spotted Spurge. Don't apply to Centipede or Carpelgrass lawns during the period of winter dormancy.
