PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increases the toxic effects of Thiram. May cause skin irritation. Do not inhale dust. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use grass clippings for food or feed purposes.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY BEFORE APPLICATION. USE THIS PRODUCT ONLY FOR RECOMMENDED PURPOSES AND AT RECOMMENDED DOSAGE.

Do not rotate treated crop with crops other than those with registered Thiram uses.

Do not re-enter treated areas within 24 hours following application unless protective clothing is worn.

Use this product for the control of Brown Patch, Dollar Spot and Snow Mold in lawns and as an animal repellent. Thiram is a taste repellent that is effective only on animals attempting to feed on the treated foliage. Use in sufficient water for good coverage.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

ANIMAL REPELLENT: To protect trees, shrubs, nursery stock and ornamentals for 6 months or longer (depending on weather and other conditions) from rabbits, meadow mice and deer, use a mixture of 1 lb. of this product, 3 qts. of water and 2 lbs. of weather resistant sticker. Do not mix more repellent than can be used in a short time. Apply when plants are dormant or growing but before expected time of animal damage. Use only when surfaces of plants to be treated are dry and under favorable drying conditions.

SPRAY APPLICATION: Apply mixture as a full coverage spray with hand or mechanical sprayer. For tree seedlings, do not treat more than 3,000 seedlings per gallon of finished spray.

DIP APPLICATION: Apply mixture to bundles of tree planting stock by dipping to thoroughly wet foliage and other parts to be protected. Permit excess repellent to run off treated plants without coming in contact with roots.

Bundles of tree planting stock that are treated with this product must bear distinct labeling that instructs "CAUTION: Treated with Thiram". Wear rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling products treated with Thiram. Direct exposure to skin may result in severe dermatitis.

BRUSH APPLICATION: Apply on lower trunk of fruit trees or ornamental plantings from ground level to a height of 2-1/2 feet to protect plants from trunk injury.

DO NOT USE ON PLANT PARTS THAT ARE TO BE USED FOR FOOD OR FEED.

BROWN PATCH AND DOLLAR SPOT: Use 6 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply early before diseases appear. During summer when periods of high temperature and humidity are favorable for disease development, apply at 10-day intervals.

SNOW MOLD: Use 8 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. in late fall before snow falls and 4 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. in spring just after snow has melted. If repeated rains or periods of thawing occur, treatment at lower rate during open period in mid-winter will provide added protection.

NOTE: 1 oz. equals 6 level tablespoonsful.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse bag.
