This product is designed for control of broadleaf weeds in lawns such as: Bindweed, Black Medic, Blue Lettuce, Buckhorn, Burdock, Chickory, Chickweed, Cinquefoil, Ground Ivy, Hawkweed, Heal-All, Henbit, Jewelweed, Jimson Weed, Knotweed, Kochia, Lambsquarter, Mallow, Morning Glory, Mustard, Nettles, Oxalis, Pennywort, Peppergrass, Pigweed, Plantain, Poverty Weed, Purslane, Ragweed, Shepherd's Purse, Smartweed, Speedwell, Spotted Spurge, Thistle, Vervains, Vetch, White Aster, Wild Radish, Yarrow.

**READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY BEFORE APPLICATION.**

This product may be used on Bluegrass, Fescue, Rye, Bermuda, Bahia, and Zoysia lawns. DO NOT USE on Dichondra, Carpetgrass, St. Augustinegrass, Bentgrass, Centipede or ground cover. DO NOT USE this product where desirable clovers are present or allow the product to "wind drift" on flowers, vegetables, or ornamental shrubbery. If accidentally deposited on flowers or shrubs, hose off immediately. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.

**WHEN TO APPLY**

Best results are obtained when weeds are growing rapidly in spring or early fall. To avoid injury to new growth, new lawns should not be treated until after the fourth mowing. Established lawns may be injured if treated when in need of water. Grass may be injured if treated in periods of high heat and humidity. For this reason, apply only when the daytime temperature is not expected to exceed 80°F within 48 hours. Delay planting grass seed until 4 weeks after treatment.

**HOW TO APPLY**

This 50 pound bag should be used on 12,500 sq. ft. Apply evenly with a lawn spreader, either as a one pass application or a two pass application, criss-crossing the area at half the rate each time. Apply to lawn when the grass is wet after rain, sprinkling or dew so granules will stick to weeds. Do not water or mow lawn for at least two days after treatment. Lawns that are heavily overrun by weeds and that are in poor condition may require more than one application of this product. A suggested second application should be made in approximately 30 days.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL****FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse bag.
