January 15, 1999 GDE Revocation Notice,
Comply with WPS
Lindane 25% Wettable Powder
EPA Registration Number 8660-53
Your submission dated June 23, 2000

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), are acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a) In the Statement of Practical Treatment, in the IF SWALLOWED advice add "or" between "unconscious" and "convulsing".
 - b) In the Statement of Practical Treatment, add IF IN EYES advice as follows:

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water, Get medical attention.
 - c) In the Statement of Practical Treatment, add "Get medical attention." to the end of the IF INHALED advice.

- d) In the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, replace "May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin." with "May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin."
 - e) In the PPE listing for Applicators and other handlers, for uniformity, capitalize the "C" of "coveralls".
 - f) In the PPE listings for both Applicators and other handlers and for Mixer/Loaders, replace "A Dust/Mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH) approval number prefix TC-21C)" with "A respirator with either an organic-vapor removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticide (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C) or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic-vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any R, P, or HE prefilter".
 - g) In the picture guide to PPE change the dust mask to a respirator.
3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious convulsing person. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of soap and water. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

AGRICULTURAL USER REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. HOW TO USE AS A SEED TREATMENT

This product should be applied in a well ventilated area.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time.

WIREWORM IN CORN: Immediately before planting, treat seed corn with 25% Lindane Wettable Powder at the rate of 4 ounces per bushel of corn or 2 level teaspoonfuls per corn planter box. The seed and the Lindane should be thoroughly mixed; a small quantity of water (1/4 pint per bushel) may be added to aid in sticking the Lindane to the corn. Plant immediately after treating.

WIREWORM IN WHEAT and SORGHUM: Follow directions for treatment of seed corn except use 8 ounces per 100 pounds of wheat and sorghum.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate, is a violation of Federal Law and may contaminate groundwater. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instruction, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for Guidance. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty container into application equipment.
