HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT induce vomiting. Contains a Petroleum oil.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Vertagreen Pyrenone 20 New contains piperonyl butoxide and pyrethrins. It is an effective insecticide base for rapid control of flies and many other, common insect pests found in homes, institutions and buildings. It can be used around food, food products and utensils, according to directions, without danger of contamination, but should not be applied to uncovered food or foodstuffs.

Sprays prepared from Vertagreen Pyrenone 20 New according to suggested dilutions, kill on contact most common flying and crawling pests. Use in a good spray atomizer adjusted to deliver a fine mist.

FLYING INSECTS: Direct the spray toward the upper portions of the room or enclosure and fill the atmosphere with mist. Whenever possible keep doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after spraying.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Treat all areas where these insects are commonly found, particularly behind baseboards, moldings, furniture, cabinets, shelves, sinks, pipes, in cracks, crevices and similar hiding places. Repeat application as needed.

FLUSHING AND KNOCK-DOWN ADDITIVE: Vertagreen Pyrenone 30 New immediately excites and stimulates insects, aiding in locating and contacting them and insuring better exposure. Used with residual materials it gives quick knock-down and kill of the existing insect population.

VAPORIZER CONCENTRATE: Follow dilution table and recommendations of manufacturer of machine used.
