The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, to update your product labeling, is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions:

- 1. Under the Precautionary Labeling section, place the word "Corrosive" directly before the sentence "May be fatal.....swallowed."
- 2. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" directly above the signal word "Danger."
- 3. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" section to read as follows: "This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, stream, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.
- 4. Under the subheading "Directions for Greenhouse Use", place the following disclaimer, " To be used only on ornamental vegetation."

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- 5. Under the subheading "Directions for Greenhouse Use", delete the word " prevent" from the "Pot Treatment" section.
- 6. Delete the Phenol Coefficients from the labeling.
- 7. Place the subheading " Pesticide Disposal" directly above the "Disposal Instructions".
- 8. Revise the "Note to Physician" section to read as follows: "Probable mucosal damage may contradict the use of gastric lavage."



DIRECTIONS FOR GREENHOUSE USE

<u>POT TREATMENT</u>: To prevent or control algae growth on clay flower pots, dlute 1 part of Vertagreen's Algaecide with 9 parts of water and dip the flower pots in this solution for a few minutes. This treatment should keep new clay flower pots free of algae for approximately 10 to 12 weeks, or a somewhat shorter period in the case of used pots. Used pots should be cleaned as well as possible prior to dipping.

<u>BENCH AND FLAT TREATMENT</u>: Wood and concrete benches and wood flats can also be treated to prevent or control algae growth, using the dilution of 1 part of Vertagreen's Algaecide per 9 parts of water.

<u>WOODWORK TREATMENT</u>: Woodwork and other structural parts of the greenhouse on which algae formations are or can be a problem can be washed with the same dilution of Algaecide to prevent or control algae growth.

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<u>AIR CONDITIONING BAT TREATMENT</u>: With re-circulating systems, add 1 oz. of Algaecide in each 2 gallons (1 part in 250 parts water) of water capacity for system and repeat 1-250 dosage at monthly intervals. For non-circulating systems, where water is wasted or diverted, use 1 part of Algrecide with 9 parts of water to soak bats prior to installation or as an initial treatment; and repeat at monthly intervals during use season by spraying bats thoroughly with the 1-9 dilution.

PHENOL COEFFICIENTS

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Salmonella Typhose - 25 Nonflammable, nonvolatile, odorless, non-corrosive in use dilution. Nonirritating in use dilution. Do not mix with soap or anionic detergents.

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL USE

If algae growth is observed, add 1 gallon of Algaecide for each 10,000 gals. of water to kill and control algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. When existing growth is dead and algae have withered, clean the pool, draining and refilling if necessary; then add 1 gal. of Algaecide per 20,000 gals. of water.

If algae growth is absent, use 1 gal. of Algaecide for each 25,000 gals. of water to prevent growth, and add 1 quart of Algaecide per 50,000 gals. of water periodically or at about one-week intervals. To disinfect locker rooms and to guard against the spread of athletes foot fungi, clean walk ways, pool side, locker room floors, etc., with a suitable detergent, then mop with a mixture containing 1 pint of Algaecide in 4 gals. of water.

After laundering, immerse suits and caps for 10 minutes in a solution containing 1 pint of Algaecide in 4 gals. of water. Rinse in clear water, wring and hang to dry. Vertagreen Algaecide is compatible with the usual water treatment chemicals. By controlling the algae growth, the chlorine demand of the pool may be significantly reduced.
