Subject: Revised Labeling  
Vertagreen 5% Sevin Dust  
EPA Reg. No. 8660-72  
Your submission of June 25, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling change given below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. In the Environmental Hazards statement change "wetlands" to "areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."
2. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment for inhalation hazard to the label.
3. Delete the Storage and Disposal statement for Professional/Commercial use since your product is clearly labeled for homeowner use only.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. You also need to respond to our letter dated August 30, 1990 regarding the alternate confidential statement of formula. We must have your response within 45 days from the date of this letter.

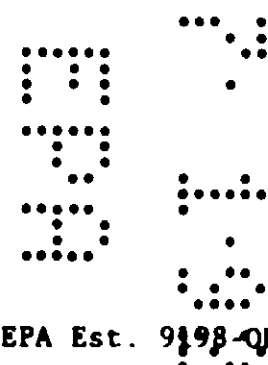

CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists get medical attention.

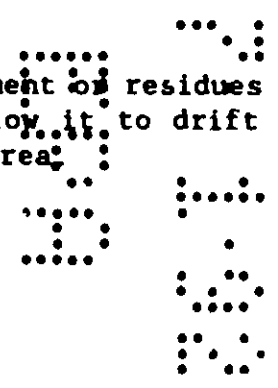
**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment of residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.



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**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply this product when insects or their damage appear. Make applications in the morning or evening when it is cool. Treat upper and lower surfaces of all foliage for complete coverage. For best results apply with a "dust gun". Repeat as necessary, generally at 7 day intervals. Do not apply in excess. Make applications when the foliage is dry. Subsequent planting of food or feed crops in treated soil must be with crops listed on this or other carbaryl product labels.

BEANS (Green Beans, Lima Beans, Snap Beans, Cowpeas, Blackeyed): Mexican Bean Beetles, Bean Leaf Beetle, Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetles, Leafhoppers, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Western Bean Cutworm, Armyworms, Corn Earworms, Stink Bugs and Tarnished Plant Bugs . . . . . No Limit  
Use 3/4 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

CUCUMBERS, MELONS, PUMPKINS, SQUASH:  
Pickleworm, Melonworm, Cucumber Beetle, Flea Beetle, Leafhopper, and Squash Bug.  
Avoid excessive applications. Do not apply to wet foliage. . . . . No limit  
Use 1/3 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

POTATO, TOMATO, EGGPLANT, PEPPERS:  
Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetles, Leafhopper, European Corn Borer, Fall Armyworm, Lace Bugs, Tomato Fruit Worm, Tomato Hornworm, Tarnished Plant Bugs, Stink Bugs . . . . . No limit  
Use 3/4 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

ASPARAGUS:  
Asparagus Beetle and Apache Cicada  
(Do not repeat application within 3 days) . . . . . 1 Day  
Use 2/3 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

CARROTS (No time limit), HEAD LETTUCE, HORSERADISH, PARSNIPS, RADISHES, RUTABAGAS:  
Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bug, Leafhoppers, Armyworms, Corn Earworms, Spittlebugs, Tarnished Plant Bugs and Stink Bugs . . . . . 3 Days  
Use 3/4 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

**TIME TO STOP USE  
BEFORE HARVEST**

**FOR CONTROL OF LISTED INSECTS:**

**CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS,**

**CAULIFLOWER, KOHLRABI:**

Flea Beetle, Harlequin Bug, Armyworms,  
Imported Cabbage Worm, Corn Earworm . . . . . 3 Days  
Use 3/4 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

**STRAWBERRIES:**

Meadow Spittle Bug, Strawberry Leaf Roller  
and Strawberry Weevil . . . . . 1 Day  
Use 3/4 lb./1,000 sq. ft.

**GRASSHOPPERS ON THE ABOVE CROPS:** Apply at the dosages and limitations given for each crop and repeat as necessary to control Grasshoppers.

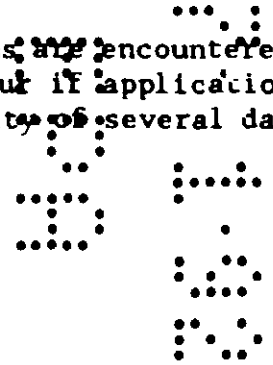
**ORNAMENTALS:** Vertagreen 5% Sevin Dust can be used on a wide range of ornamental plants, flowers, shrubs and small trees, namely Arbor Vitae, Azaleas, Birch, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Dogwoods, Elms, Gladiolus, Hydrangea, Juniper, Lilacs, Maple, Oak, Pines, and Roses. Do not use on Boston Ivy.

Apply to upper and lower leaf surface and all foliage for complete coverage to control such pests as Apple Aphids, Bagworms, Birch Leaf Miner, Blister Beetles, Boxelder Bugs, Boxwood Leaf Miner, Elm Leaf Aphid, Elm Leaf Beetle, Flea Beetles, Gypsy Moth, Japanese Beetles, Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Rose Aphids, Thrips, and Rose Slugs.

**CATS AND DOGS:** For Ticks and Fleas, dust liberally over the entire animal, avoiding the eyes, and rub thoroughly into hair. Comb out dead Ticks a few hours after treatment. Repeat at weekly intervals if needed. Avoid treatment of kittens or puppies less than 4 months of age. Do not use this product on pregnant dogs.

In and around dog and cat quarters: For Ticks and Fleas, dust liberally in and around sleeping quarters, kennels and doghouses by means of a shaker can, hand or dust gun.

**NOTE:** Sevin does not control Spider Mites. Where infestations are encountered, use a recommended miticide. Injury to tender foliage may occur if applications are made when plants are wet or in the presence of high humidity of several days duration following treatment. Do not use on Boston Ivy.



**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.

**FOR PROFESSIONAL/COMMERCIAL USE ONLY:**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate, is a violation of Federal Law and may contaminate groundwater. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instruction, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for Guidance. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. 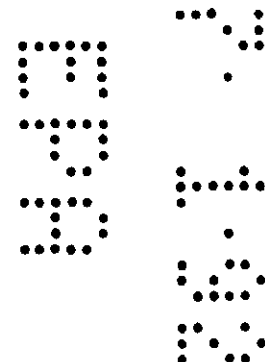
