Revise the environmental hazards wetlands statement to:

"Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the means high water mark."

Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to include the following eye precaution:

- "IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

This product contains metaldehyde. It attracts and kills Slugs and Snails. Since Slugs and Snails move and feed at night the bait works best when applied late in the afternoon or at dusk. Apply when the ground is moist or wet, but do not apply just before a rain. Treat area as uniformly as possible at the rate of 1 lb. per 1,200 sq. ft. (1-1/3 oz. per 100 sq. ft.). Where plants are close together use 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

Good sanitation and the removal of loose boards, bricks, trash piles, or other material which might offer shelter, will add to the effectiveness of the control measures. Slug and Snail damage is often mistaken for damage by other insects and the destruction of seedlings and plants may be wrongly attributed to Cutworms or other insects. The presence of Slugs and Snails can be determined by their shiny mucous-like trails.

SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS

ORNAMENTALS: Apply to the soil around stem or stalk, Will control damage to flowers such as Begonias, Geranium, Petunia, and Phlox.

<u>VEGETABLES</u>: Bait the soil area around Beans, Cabbage, Corn, Lettuce, Melons, Peas, Peppers, Tomatoes, and Turnips. Do not let pellets remain on plant tissue but brush them to the soil area. Also treat the soil area around sets of Cabbage, Cauliflower, Pepper and Tomatoes. Do not contaminate edible parts.

<u>FRUIT</u>: For Strawberries, treat area as close to plant base as possible by lifting leaves and placing pellets beneath. Do not apply within 6 days of harvest.

GREENHOUSE: Bait as soon after irrigation as practical. Delay next watering to allow time for Slug and Snail control. Bait areas beneath growing benches, near soil compost piles and potting benches. Rate will vary with plant population. Use 1 lb. to treat 800 to 1,600 sq. ft. Treat the soil around flowers or vegetables (Cucumber, Lettuce, Radish, Tomatoes). Do not contaminate edible parts.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL**: Do not reuse bag.
