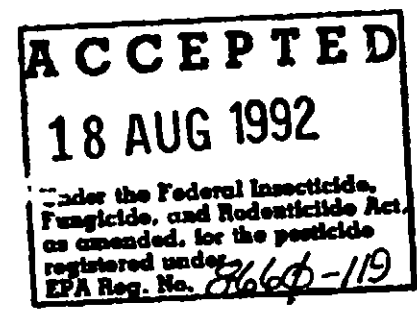

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

This product is ready to use. To control insects named in the chart, apply to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment weekly or as needed to control infestations.

PLANTS

African Violets, Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Carnations, Camellias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Dogwood, Geraniums, Gladiolus, Marigolds, Roses, & Wandering Jew

INDOOR INSECT CONTROL

Adjust sprayer to give a fine "floating" mist as space spray to control Flies. Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Small Flying Insect Moths.

Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close windows, and doors and shut off ventilating systems. Direct the spray mist toward the upper portions of the enclosure filling the room with the mist and hitting as many insects with the spray as possible.

Use 2 to 4 oz. per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Keep area closed for at least 30 minutes. Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

OUT-OF-DOORS ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL

Apply as fine mist to thoroughly treat the entire area. For best results, treat when the wind velocity does not exceed 5 miles per hour. (Treat when it is calm.) Treat shrubbery and vegetation where mosquitoes may rest, particularly around mosquito breeding places such as swamps, marshes, stagnant pools and ponds. Apply at the rate of 4 oz. of this product per 1,000 sq. ft. of area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse bag.
