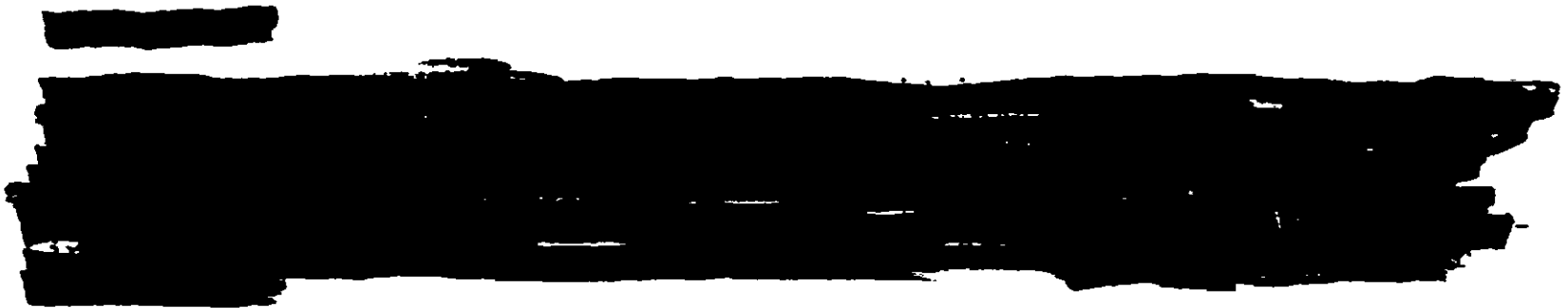

PREMISE & BAND TREATMENT AROUND HOME FOUNDATIONS - Apply a band of Granules 5 feet wide around the dwelling next to the house foundation as a barrier against insects invading the home. Use 4 ounces of product to treat a band 5 feet wide and 20 feet long around the foundation. One pound will treat up to 500 Sq. Ft. (5'x 100' band). This treatment will control commonly found insects which may be present such as Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sowbugs, Springtails & Spiders. Apply the protective band around the home when insects are present and are causing problems, especially in the late spring or early fall. Repeat as necessary for control.
