STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Have victim drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection only is an antidote.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Do not take internally. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention if irritation develops or persists. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to birds, fish, and aquatic invertebrate. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Clean up spilled product to reduce exposure to wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas between the mean high water mark. Runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. TO CONTROL CHINCH BUGS, SOD WEBWORMS, ANTS, ARMYWORMS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, FLEAS AND SOWBUGS

Uniformly apply 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq.ft. or 25 lbs. to cover 5,000 sq.ft. of noncrop turfgrass area using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear; retreat as needed. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one directions; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, thoroughly water the treated turf to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.
