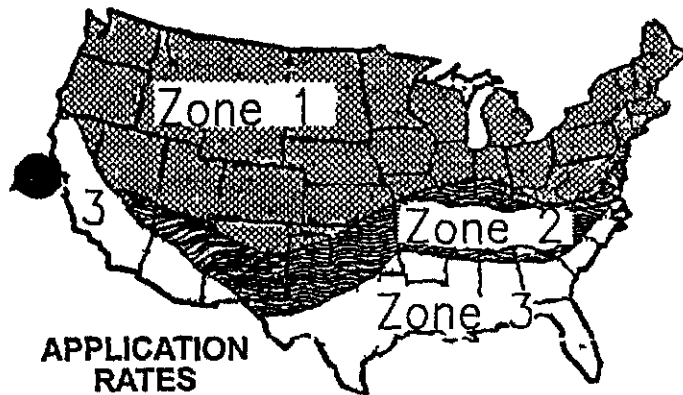

Control of weeds occurs when the active ingredient herbicide, Proflaminate, is absorbed by the roots of germinating weed seedlings. Effective control of these weeds will occur only when this product is applied one to two weeks before weed seed germination and is activated by 1/2 inch of water within 14 days of application. The following rates of application will control weeds for a period of 2 to 6 months. Highest rates will provide more consistent control for longer periods of time.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Do not use on dichondra or newly sprigged areas of St. Augustinegrass Bermudagrass or Centipedegrass until these areas are well established. Do not apply to turfgrass seeded the previous fall until these areas are well established (minimum of three mowings). Water the lawn with 1/4 to 1/2 inch of water after application to allow the material to form the "barrier" on the soil surface necessary for adequate weed control. Do not rake, thatch, aerate or otherwise disturb this "barrier" after application. Use highest rates for lawn that have a history of severe weed problems. Delay reseeding of treated areas for 8 to 10 weeks after application.

SPREADER SETTINGS

Your spreader must be properly calibrated. It should accurately spread the required 20 lbs of product to cover the desired square feet (4,400, 5,000, 6,000 or 10,000) in order for this product to effectively control weeds. (See "settings" in the chart which are based on "new equipment" spreaders.) Used spreaders may need recalibrating due to old or worn parts. To allow for this, check your spreader by applying the amount of this product needed for 500 sq. ft. (such as 2 lbs./500 sq. ft. which is equal to the 20#/5,000 sq. ft. rate) and use the spreader settings found in the adjacent chart.
