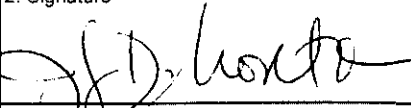

This product is recommended for the control of lawn insects, as listed, in outdoor residential areas.

- Lawn treatments can be made to ornamental and turfgrass areas and under shrubbery with a fertilizer spreader.
- Spot treatments can be made to ant mounds.

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

1. Determine size of area to be treated – measure length and width in feet, then multiply to determine coverage area in sq ft.
2. Use the spreader setting chart to determine appropriate setting.
3. Treat as directed – thorough coverage is important. Water in as indicated on the label.
4. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into turf and grass is dry.

LAWN TREATMENT FOR GRASS AND DICHONDRA LAWNS

To control:

Ants, Armyworms (Including Fall, Yellowstriped), Bermudagrass mites, Billbugs (adult), Box Elder Bugs, Chiggers, Chinch Bugs, Clover mites, Crickets, Cutworms, Darkling Ground Beetles, Essex Skippers, European Crane Fly Larvae, Field Crickets, Fiery Skippers, Flea Beetles (in

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Dichondra), Grasshoppers, Hyperodes (Turfgrass) Weevil, Japanese Beetle (adult), Lawn Moths, Leafhoppers, Silverfish, Firebrats, Sod Webworms, Sowbugs, Spittlebugs, Springtails, Vegetable Weevils (in Dichondra).

- Apply this product uniformly to home lawns, under shrubbery and other ornamental or recreational turf grass areas.
- Apply when insects first appear using granules at the rate of 2.5 lbs per 1,000 sq ft.
- For thicker lawns (such as St. Augustine grass) apply at a rate of 4 lbs per 1,000 sq ft.
- Always use a fertilizer spreader.
- See spreader setting chart below.
- Immediately after application, water the lawn with ¼ to ½ inches of water.
- If necessary reapply in 4 to 6 weeks.

European Crane Fly Larvae (Leatherjackets) – the best time to apply is in May or June when the insects are young.

Chinch Bugs – Begin application when temperatures reach 80°F or above. A second application may be necessary in 6 weeks if insect activity continues.

SPOT TREATMENT

OUTDOOR ANT MOUNDS

This product may be used outdoors for the control of ants including: **Acrobat, Argentine, Big Headed, Cornfield, Field, Harvester, Leafcutter, Little Black, Pavement and Pyramid Ants.**

It is best to locate the mound and treat it first. Mounds will usually be found in the ground but may be concealed under stones, boards and slabs, in stumps or in logs.

- Apply 1 teaspoon to 1 Tablespoon of product to thoroughly cover the mound.
- Sprinkle lightly with water.

ALTERNATE DIRECTIONS FOR SHAKER-TYPE CANNISTER

- Evenly sprinkle granules over and around each ant hill.
- Use 1-2 teaspoons per ant hill.
- Gently water treated areas.

2. Using a drop-type or rotary spreader, apply granules evenly over grass, avoiding streaking, skips or overlaps. Avoid using spreaders that apply product in narrow or concentrated bands.
3. Check calibration of spreader frequently to ensure spreader is functioning properly and applying product evenly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store product in original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children and pets. **Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Please find enclosed our notification per PR Notice 98-10 to revise the following pesticide claim as requested by the state of Hawaii. We are adding the word "our" to further clarify ownership of the product. The revised claim will read: "*Kills Lawn Damaging Insects on Contact with Same Active Ingredient Used in Our Spectracide Bug Stop*". In addition, we are adding the pesticide claim, "**CONTAINS PERMETHRIN, THE SAME ACTIVE INGREDIENT USED IN OUR SPECTRACIDE BUG STOP**".

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
