The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. There is an inconsistency in the "Directions for Use" section. The sentence "Repeat as needed." is preceded by the mandatory element from PR Notice 91-4 "Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness." This inconsistency needs to be corrected in some way, perhaps by deleting the sentence "Repeat as needed."
2. The following sentences listed in the "Precautionary Statements" section must be moved to the "Directions for Use" section:
 - a. Do not apply to sunburned, damaged, cut or wounded/irritated skin.
 - b. Do not apply to eyes, lips, and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children.

Five copies of finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.
