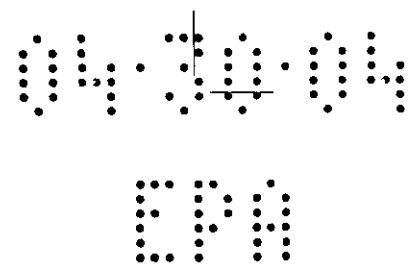

FIRST AID
