The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision:

The heading Active Ingredients should be made singular.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit five (5) final printed copies for the referenced label, incorporating the above change, before releasing the product for shipment.

The Agency has reviewed your submission of the Confidential Statement of Formula for an alternate formulation dated April 5, 1993, and the following comments apply:

The upper and lower certified limits for the active component should be based on the pure active ingredient rather than the technical or concentrate and thus should bracket (i.e., be higher and lower, respectively) the active ingredient label claim of your finished product.

Please submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula, incorporating the changes indicated above.

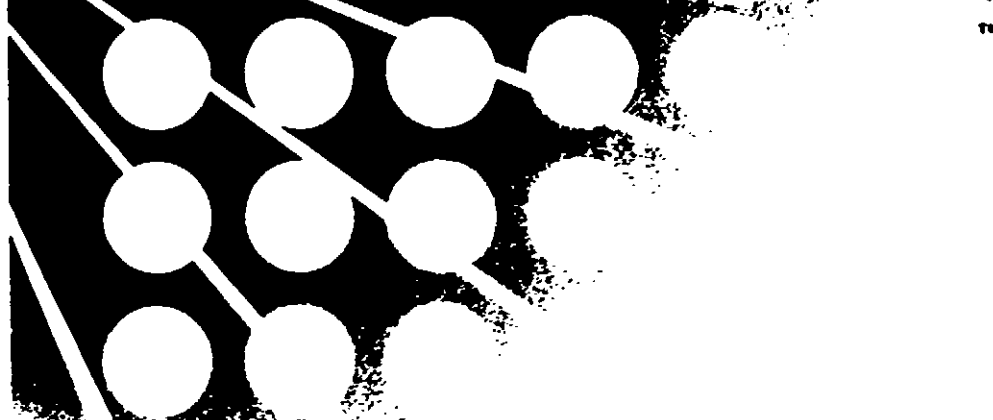

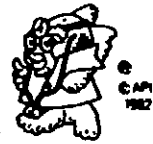
