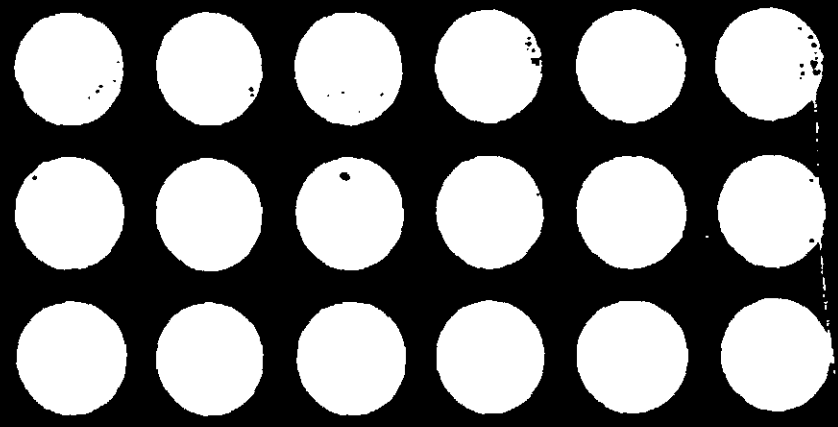

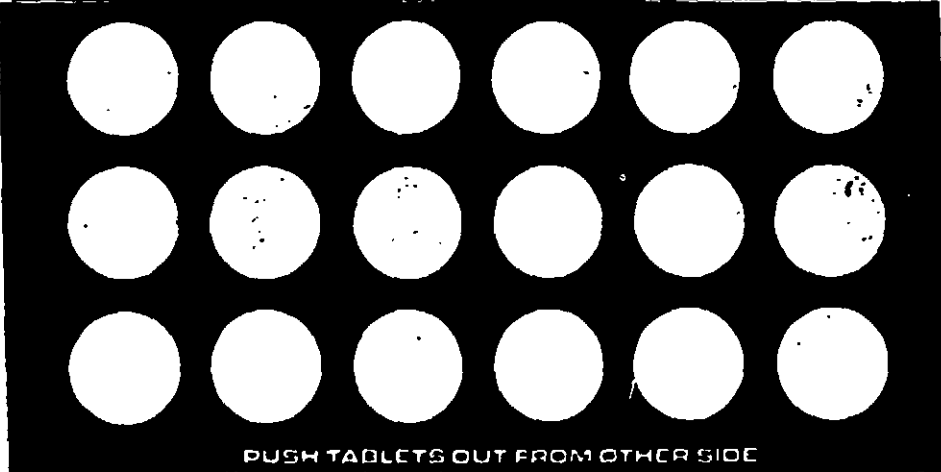

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Press 1 tablet through foil backing for each 50 gallons of pond water. This treatment is normally effective for several weeks. Repeat treatment when algae growth reappears. The best time to use ALGAE DESTROYER is between April 1 and June 15 when water temperature is low. Higher temperatures cause rapid decay of dead weeds and algae, reducing the oxygen content of water. When pond temperature exceeds 75 degrees F, aeration of the pond is required to avoid fish stress. **PRECAUTION:** Treatment may injure water hyacinths and water lilies. Distribute tablets uniformly around the pond.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a dry place. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
