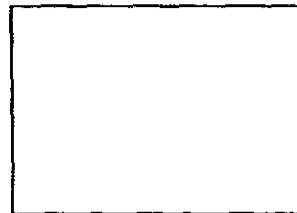

Press 1 tablet through foil backing for each 50 gallons (190 L) of pond water. This treatment is normally effective for several weeks. Repeat treatment when algae growth reappears. The best time to use ALGAE DESTROYER for Ponds is when the water temperature is low (between April 1 and June 15). Higher temperatures cause rapid decay of dead weeds and algae, reducing the oxygen content of water. When pond temperature exceeds 75°F (24°C), aeration of the pond is required to avoid fish stress. **PRECAUTION:** Treatment may injure water hyacinths and waterlilies. Distribute tablets uniformly around the pond.

Store in a dry place. Do not contaminate water or feed. Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
