FLIES, MOSQUITOS, GNATS, ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH

FOR FLIES, GNATS and MOSQUITOS: CLOSE ALL DOORS AND WINDOWS

The room should be kept closed for 10 to 15 minutes and insects destroyed. Repeat as often as necessary.

FOR ROACHES, ANTS AND SILVERFISH: Inspect for and eliminate suspected of harboring these pests. Pay particular attention to areas around sinks and food storage areas. Wash dishes and clean up in all cases that the insects be contacted directly with the spray. Repeat the above procedure as often as necessary.

* Note: This spray should be used in case of infestation of food and food utensils. If any spray contaminates clothing, it should be thoroughly cleaned.

FOR CLOTHES MOTH and CARPET BEETLE: Thoroughly spray them thoroughly, giving particular attention to trunks, closets, cupboards, and other storage areas. Seal moth tight containers or repeat above procedure. For furniture, spray thoroughly both interior and exterior surfaces. Repeat on both top surfaces and underneath surfaces. If the problem, the use of UN-CHEM RESIDUAL ROACH KILLER is recommended.

BED BUGS; Spray thoroughly the bed, mattress, bed boards and wall cracks about the bed. Repeat as often as necessary for good results against these pests.

FOR FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray cracks and crevices, sleeping quarters, and other areas where they may be suspected of harboring. Repeat as often as necessary. Flea and tick pests are desirable in all cases.

Keep Out of Reach of Children

Harmful if swallowed. Do not use on cats, dogs, or other animals. Keep container tightly closed.
