**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For control of ticks, fleas and lice on dogs and cats, dilute 4 ounces of ENTIX with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Repeat as necessary for control.
