The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling (Carton Label).

- a. Place the signal word "DANGER" to appear directly below the statement: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- b. Add the following statements: (right panel)

Precautionary Statements  
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

- c. Add the following statements: (left panel)

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- d. In lieu of the statement:

Not for use in or around the home

the following statement is required to comply with Child-Resistant Packaging regulations:

Only for Sale To, Use, and Storage by Service Persons.

This statement must be at least the same type size as the "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" statement and preferably placed in the upper front panel.

- e. The following statement must be revised and added to the use directions to clearly indicate that the product is a two-step cleaner disinfectant. Ref: DIS/SS-15 enclosure.

(1) Revise the statement:

Remove gross filth and heavy soils prior to the application of the disinfecting solution

to read:

Remove gross filth and heavy soiled deposits. Pre-clean all surfaces prior to disinfection product application.

Note: Instruction only for the removal of gross filth and heavy soils implies that your product will be effective as a disinfectant in the presence of moderate amounts of soil. Such an instruction is only appropriate for one-step cleaner disinfectant products.

(2) Add the following statements:

Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Prepare a fresh use solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

- f. Delete the Phenol Coefficient claims from the label.

Phenol Coefficient claims are permitted only on the labels of those products when the value claimed can be considered meaningful, and not misleading. Only if the Phenol Coefficient of a product, as claimed on the label, can be multiplied by the factor "20" to provide the effective use dilution of the product (as confirmed by the AOAC Use-Dilution Method) will the claim be permitted on the label. Since this is not true for this product, the Phenol Coefficient values must be deleted.

- g. Revise the statement:

"...furniture, washroom fixtures, etc., in hospitals...."

to read:

"...furniture, washroom fixtures and other hard nonporous inanimate surfaces in hospitals...."

- h. The letter "a" within the word alkyl must be capitalized. (Active Ingredient Section)
- i. Product formulations of this type have been reevaluated by our toxicologists. Revise your entire precautionary labeling statements:

Harmful if swallowed. Do not get...medical attention. Avoid contamination of food

to read:

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling: (ENVELOPE LABEL).

- a. Revise the statement:

Not for use in or around the home

to read:

Only for Sale To, Use, and Storage by Service Persons.


3. The submitted revised Confidential Statement of Formula and all the alternate sources of supply for the active and inert ingredients in this formulation are acceptable.
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling (both carton and envelope) before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-7; Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
