For use in washing machines, hand
washing, etc. Use 1/2 cup per quart of water.
For use in front-loading machines, use
1 cup per quart of water.

DIRECTIONS: Wash thoroughly with warm suds. Rinse. Then
soak for 5 minutes in solution of 1/2 cup bleach per quart of water.
Rinse well. (Do not use on silverware.)

**REFRIGERATORS, STOVES, CUPBOARDS,
UNPAINTED WOOD, AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT**

DIRECTIONS: Wash thoroughly with warm suds. Use 1/2 cup
bleach per 4 gallons of water. Spread with cloth - let stand 2
minutes. Rinse well. (This is a standard disinfecting solution
recommended by U. S. Public Health Service - 200ppm available
chlorine.)

RESTAURANTS, HOTELS, ETC.

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever
possible.

2. Wash with a good compatible detergent.

3. Rinse with clean water.

4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 oz. to 4 gals. of water, 200ppm.
Immerse all utensils for at least 2 minutes or for contact time
specified by governing sanitary codes.

5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

TEST KIT: Use a test kit to determine Available Chlorine - 200ppm.
Use 1 oz. per 4 gals. water.

CAUTION: See label for first aid
instructions. Keep out of reach of children.

DIRECTIONS

LAUNDERING: For bleaching and sanitizing white or color-fast cottons, linens, nylon, dacron, orlon, rayon, use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per 4 gals. water or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per washing machine load in top-loading machines; 1 cup in front-loading machines. Use bleach in washing machine or first rinse.

Wash or soak for 10 minutes. Rinse well. If clothes are already in machine, dilute bleach before using.

REMOVING STAINS: For stubborn stains from fruit, grass, tea, coffee, scorch, ink, mildew, etc. use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup bleach per quart of water. Soak stained area in bleach solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary. Colored fabrics — Test small piece before using. Use in glass, rubber, porcelain or enameled containers.

CLEANING KITCHEN & BATHROOM: To clean sinks, bathtubs, tile, linoleum, porcelain, enameled metal, etc., use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup bleach per quart of water. Spread bleach solution with cloth. Let stand for only 2 minutes. Rinse well.

WHITENING AGE-YELLOWED NYLON: To whiten nylon that has yellowed with age use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per 4 quarts of warm water.

DIRECTIONS

USE FOR WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY

IN THE LAUNDRY: Add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup of bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. As a bleach add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup or 1 oz. per 2 gallons water or one cup of bleach per each washing machine load (16 gallon machine). Rinse in several waters before drying. In automatics bleach should be added to suds water before clothing is placed in machine. If added while clothing is in suds, dilute with 1 quart of water before adding.

DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, OR ACETATE.

STAIN REMOVER: To remove scorch, ink, fruit, tea, coffee, grass, or other stains, add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup of bleach to quart of water. Mix well and allow to soak until stains disappear. Rinse thoroughly.

TO CLEANSE OR DEODORIZE: All surfaces in bathroom and kitchen use 1 oz. or $\frac{1}{8}$ cup of bleach per 2 gallons of water. Cleanse surfaces with warm suds. Rinse. Follow with bleach solution. Soak 5 minutes. Rinse well.

DISINFECTANT: Dish cloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, etc. First wash in clean water; immerse for 5 minutes in solution of 3 tablespoons of bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water. Rinse and dry.

SICK ROOM: To disinfect and deodorize. Use 3 tablespoons bleach per each quart of water. For rubber sheets, bedpans, etc., immerse for 5 minutes and rinse.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Bleach will irritate skin or eyes. Rinse immediately. If taken internally, feed cooked cereal followed by salad oil. Call a doctor.

Do not use in copper, aluminum or iron vessels. Use in porcelain or enamel lined vessel.
