This automatic feeder is designed to give shock treatment to algae and slime. Then it maintains a killing concentration for several weeks. This method avoids the build up of immunity by algae and slime.

DIRECTIONS

Use one can per 25 tons or less refrigeration. This is sufficient to treat 12,000 gallons water per month. Before using remove this label from can. Do not remove the lid. Place can in sump tank with top up. Algaecide feeds from lower hole in side of can.

Use Precision Algaecide Briquettes in Automatic Feeder can each month or as algae reappears. Empty any content left in old can into sump tank when recharging with new cans.

WARNING: Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe dust or spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. In case of swallowing, induce vomiting by administering warm salt water (one table-spoon per glass) or other emetic. Call a physician. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife.
