Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use, and before eating or smoking. Do not smoke while using. Keep out of reach of children; do not allow children in treated areas until dry.

Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible products areas of food processing plants. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Remove birds and cover fish bowls when spraying. Do not allow pets on treated areas until dry. Do not spray on plants or shrubbery. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold can as upright as possible when spraying. Do not spray up into the air. Apply to surfaces only. Hold can about 12" from surface to be sprayed, point spray nozzle toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Spray until surfaces are wet in cracks, around baseboards, behind and beneath appliances, in and around waste containers, and other hiding places. To insure greater killing power, spray 5 to 10 seconds in each corner area. Repeat applications as needed to maintain control.

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
