

We regret this was overlooked in our past review.

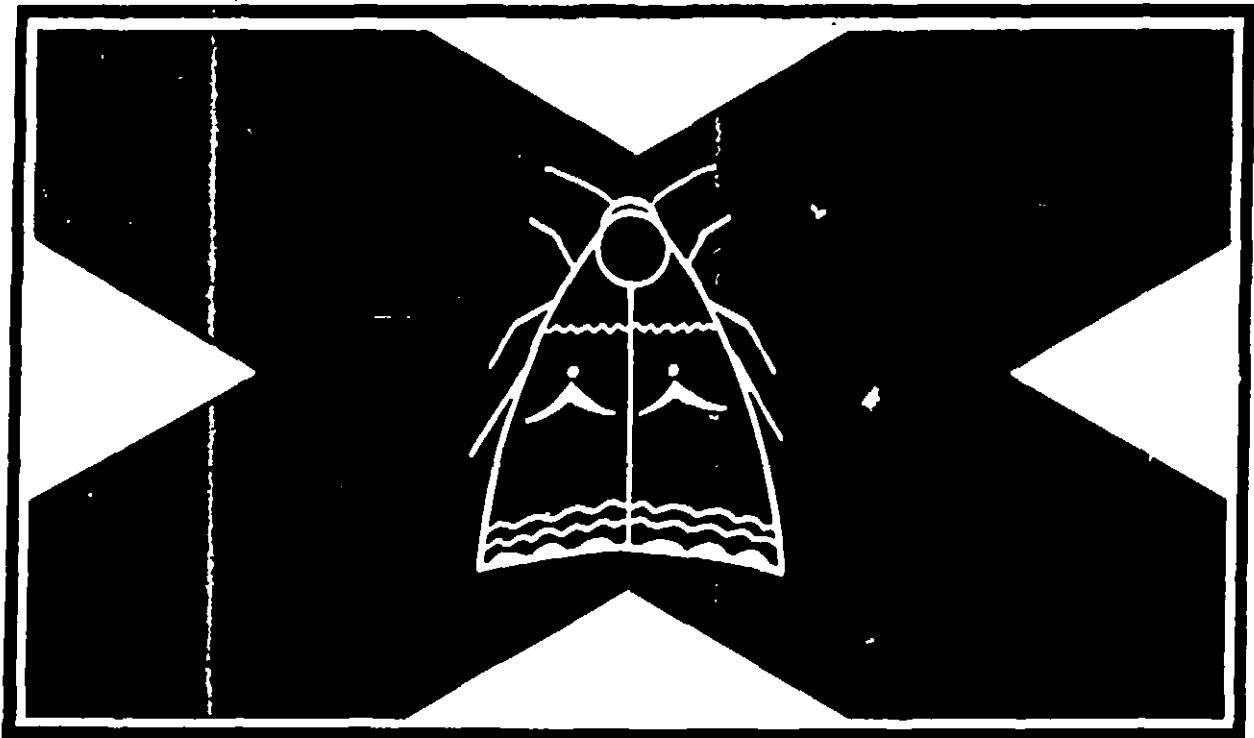
