

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

Do not open protective pouch until ready to use. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If irritation occurs seek medical attention.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place until used. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap bait before disposing in trash.

#### DIRECTION FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN JAPANESE BEETLE TRAPS: Attach the food lure dispenser to the Japanese beetle trap. Use one food lure dispenser per trap. For incroved beetle catches, HERCON JAPANESE BEETLE FOOD LURE is recommended for use with the Japanese beetle sex attractant baits such as HERCON LURETAPE with JAPONILURE. Follow Japanese beetle trap label for application rate and other directions.

Replacement: Under ordinary weather conditions, the floral lure should be effective for about twelve weeks. They should be replaced after this period, or when their floral aroma is no longer readily noticeable.
