RECOMMENDED APPLICATION: For use on peaches, nectarines, apricots, plums, prunes, cherries and other stone fruits; almonds and other tree nut crops, and other crops where the peach twig borer is a problem. The recommended application rate of **DISRUPT PTB** is 200 dispensers per acre; this is equivalent to 20 grams of peach twig borer pheromone AI per acre. Repeat application as needed but do not exceed a total of 150 grams AI per acre per year.

METHOD OF APPLICATION: Do not open pouches until ready to use. Do not use DISRUPT PTB from damaged, punctured or unsealed bags. Apply DISRUPT PTB early in the season after the first peach twig borer moth is detected with a pheromone-baited trap, such as the Hercon PTB Scout monitoring system.

Remove one dispenser from the pouch and apply by hand to small limbs of crop to be protected. Place dispensers 6 to 8 feet from the ground or higher, if desired, preferably on the south side of the tree. Attach dispenser by pushing limb into the center notch of the dispenser holder. If there is a prevalent wind, apply one dispenser to every tree on the upwind side of the orchard and then evenly distribute any remaining dispensers in the block. Reapply **DISRUPT PTB** after 105 days, or earlier as needed, based on local conditions and monitoring results and field scouting
