**HAZARD TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION:** May be harmful if swallowed or chewed. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not allow children to handle this collar. Do not open protective pouch until ready to use. Wash thoroughly after handling. Some dogs may be sensitive to this product. When collar is first worn, observe neck area and remove collar at first sign of adverse reactions. Collar is intended for use as an insecticide dispenser and is not to be taken internally by man or animals. Do not use on sick or convalescing dogs. Do not use other pesticides on dogs while collar is worn. Do not use on dogs under 6 weeks of age.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat.

If on Skin: Wash with soap and water.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water.

Note to Physicians: This product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove collar, buckle and "D" ring from package. Insert one end of the collar into one end of the buckle and close the clasp completely to secure the collar. Slide "D" ring on collar (if desired), place collar around dog's neck, insert free end of the collar in the other end of the buckle and adjust for proper fit. Close the remaining clasp completely to secure collar. Collar should be worn loosely to prevent irritation. Attach collar so two or three fingers can be inserted easily between collar and dog's neck. Cut off any excess length and dispose properly. The collar starts killing fleas as soon as it is placed around the dog's neck. Fleas on the animal will be killed and new ones which may temporarily appear will also be killed while collar is worn. Replace collar after 6 months or when effectiveness diminishes.

When the collar is first placed on the dog, adult ticks will be killed in a few days and will fall off or may then be easily removed. Immature ticks which are small and difficult to see are also killed by the HERCON FLEA & TICK 10% collar. The insecticide released continuously by the collar will also kill ticks that may carry and transmit Rocky Mountain spotted fever and tularemia.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry place.

**PRODUCT DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap used collar in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty pouch. Wrap pouch in newspaper and discard in trash.
