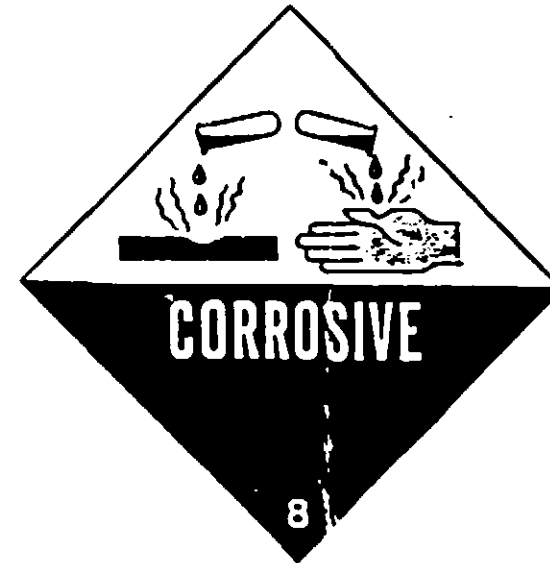

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Packhouse Sanitation: Use 1 quart (0.95 liter) in 30 gallons (113.6 liters) of water as a general sanitizing spray to reduce bacterial and fungal contamination of walls, floors, conveyors, and harvesting containers. Do not wash Citrus Fruits (Postharvest): Blue seed, green seed, citrus canner, and stem-end rot - dilute one gallon (3.8 liter) of Freshgard 5 with 175 gallons (662 liter) water to make a 2.0% sodium o-phenylphenate tetrahydrate foam washing solution. Apply to fruit with a foam generator for cleaning and decay control. Treat for between a minimum time of 30 seconds to a maximum time of 1 minute. Follow treatment with a potable water rinse.

Apples & Pears (Postharvest): Bacterial and fungal decay and rot - Dilute one gallon (3.8 liter) of Freshgard 5 with 19 gallons (72 liters) of water to make a 1.89% sodium o-phenylphenate tetrahydrate foam washing solution. Apply to fruit with a foam generator for cleaning and decay control. Treat for 15 to 30 seconds. Follow treatment with a potable water rinse.
