

Packinghouse Sanitation: Use 1 quart (0.95 liters) in 30 gallons (113.6 liters) of water as a general sanitizing spray to reduce bacterial and fungal contamination on walls, floors, conveyors, and harvesting containers. Do not rinse.

Citrus Fruits (Postharvest): Blue mold, green mold, citrus canker, and stem rot — dilute one gallon (3.8 liters) of Freshgard 5 with 17.5 gallons (66.2 liters) of water to make a 2.0% sodium o-phenylphenate tetrahydrate foam washing solution. Apply to fruit with a foam generator for cleaning and decay control. Treat for between a minimum time of 30 seconds to a maximum time of 1 minute. Follow with a treatment with a potable water rinse.

Pears (Postharvest): Bacterial and fungal decay and rots — Dilute one gallon (3.8 liters) of Freshgard 5 with 19 gallons (72 liters) of water to make a 1.86% sodium o-phenylphenate tetrahydrate foam washing solution. Apply to fruit with a foam generator for cleaning and decay control. Treat for 15 to 30 seconds. Follow with a treatment with a potable water rinse.
