Directions For Use

Citrus fruits (Postharvest): Blue mold, green mold, and stem-end rot. Mix 1 volume of Fungicide Conc. 6 uniformly with 2 to 5 volumes Flavorseal wax coating for 2200 to 1100 ppm active ingredient. Use the higher level when the decay potential is high. Apply 1 gallon of Flavorseal wax plus fungicide to each 5000 lbs. of cleaned citrus fruit in a Flavorseal wax spray applicator.

Fungicide Conc. 6 is for use only in Flavorseal wax. The final formulation of Flavorseal wax plus Fungicide is to be prepared only by an FMC serviceman.
