Directions For Use:

Citrus Fruits (Postharvest): Blue and green mold, stem-end rot. Dilute one gallon of Freshgard 50 to 20 gallons with water for a 2% sodium o-phenylphenate tetrahydrate treating solution. Apply by flooding at packinghouse ambient temperature for 2 minutes. Rinse with potable water. Maintain the proper concentration of the treating solution and a pH of 11.8 to 12.0 by the additions of Freshgard 50 and water to the reservoir as needed. Maintenance of proper pH is necessary to avoid phytotoxicity.
